



RESUMPTION OF FRESHMEN AND RETURNING STUDENTS FOR 2025/2026 ACADEMIC SESSION

Congratulations to all Freshmen on your admission to Chrisland University. This is to bring to the notice of all freshmen offered admission into Chrisland University and returning students for the 2025/2026 Academic Session, some important updates as highlighted below:

Part I - Physical Resumption to Campus are as follows:

Kindly note the following important dates as you plan to resume for the 2025/2026 academic session.

Resumption Date:

STUDENT	RESUMPTION	REMARK
100 LEVEL	Online resumption, Monday 10th November, 2025	Online class timetable will be communicated adequately. Physical resumption: January, 2026
JUEB AND DIRECT ENTRY	Friday 7 th November, 2025	Physical Resumption
200 – 300 LEVEL	Saturday 8 th November, 2025	This includes direct entry, JUPEB and returning students.
400 – 600 LEVEL	Sunday, 9 th November 2025	Returning students.

Kindly note that all freshmen will have a virtual orientation from Monday 10th – 13th November, 2025. The link will be communicated appropriately.

To access the Campus, all freshmen including the JUPEB students are expected to present:

- i. Printed evidence of payment of 60% of the prescribed fee
- ii. Printed JAMB admission letter.
- iii. Duly signed evidence of consent to the student handbook. (Kindly download a copy of the handbook from the University website); Parents are to countersign that they have read the Student Handbook along with the student.
- iv. You are also required to bring along all other document as published on the university website.

It is important to note that no freshmen will be allowed into the campus without the presentation of the above documents.

Part II Resumption Protocol

a. Registration Protocol for freshmen into Main Campus:

1. Present evidence of payment of 60% of your respective fees and JAMB admission letter at the Security Post.
2. Proceed to the Registry to obtain a clearance form.
3. Obtain clearance from the Security and the Bursary staff at the designated post.
4. Proceed to your hostels for your luggage check by the NDLEA.
5. Represent proof of payment and clearance form to the hostel staff before you are allowed into the hostel and a room allocated to you.
6. Scan the QR Code on the Hostel's notice board to join the relevant registered Whatsapp/Telegram group.

b. Registration Protocol for freshmen at the VLBC Campus:

1. Present evidence of payment of 60% of your respective fees and JAMB admission letter at the Security Post.
2. Proceed to the Relaxation Centre to get a clearance form.
3. Obtain clearance from the Security and the Bursary staff inside the relaxation centre.
4. Proceed to the NDLEA spot for your luggage check.
5. Represent proof of payment and clearance form to the hostel staff before you are allowed into the hostel and a room allocated to you.
6. Scan the QR Code on the Hostel's notice board to join the registered Whatsapp/Telegram group.

PART III VERIFICATION OF ORDINARY LEVEL RESULTS

Kindly note that your admission is subject to the verification and authentication of your O'level results at the cost of ten thousand naira only (N10,000) which is payable through the student's portal.

Part IV MEDICAL SCREENING

The University has concluded an arrangement to conduct all medical tests on Campus except Chest x-ray. All students are expected to come along with their Chest x-ray on resumption.

For the medical tests to be carried out on campus, each student is required to pay a sum of thirty thousand naira only (N30,000) using the account details specified below:

Evidence of payment is to be presented at the University clinic as part of the screening exercises.

Similarly, all students are to download medical forms on the University portal and complete relevant medical history to this effect. Other parts of the form shall be completed at the University Clinic.

Kindly note, it is recommended to arrive at 8 am. Parents/guardians who come before 9 am on Saturday/Sunday, 7th/8th November 2025 will be required to wait at the designated car park. Hostel staff, Student affairs and staff volunteers will provide assistance to students when it's 9 am.

To prevent congestion and buildup, a drop-off and drive-off policy is necessary at the halls of residence. Canopies and chairs will be provided for Parents/guardians at designated areas.
